INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS & PARTS LIST

2.0 TO CHANGE FLO-DRI CARTRIDGES



NEVER REPLACE FILTER CARTRIDGE WHEN THE UNIT IS UNDER PRESSURE. ALWAYS FOLLOW SAFE WORK PROCEDURES WHEN WORKING WITH HIGH PRESSURE.

- 2.1 Close inlet, wait for unit to vent, then close the outlet isolation valve to the FLO-DRI filter.
- 2.2 To vent filter, open drain cock. Make certain filter is COMPLETELY VENTED and under NO pressure prior to removing the top end cap.
- 2.3 To remove the end cap: depress, turn counter clockwise and pull out. DO NOT LOOSEN CASTLE NUTS.
- 2.4 Inspect filter media. Replace when completely saturated, or earlier.



DO NOT REUSE CONTAMINATED MEDIA.

- 2.5 Insert new FLO-DRI cartridge (sewn end down) into the filter unit.
- 2.6 Replace end cap, close drain cock and open isolation valves before returning FLO-DRI unit to service.



IT IS ESSENTIAL TO POSITIVELY CONFIRM CLOSURE OF TOP CAP PRIOR TO REPRESSURIZING SYSTEM.

3.0 FLO-DRI FILTER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

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


FIGURE 1 - G-10 & M-10 ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM

- 3.1 For maximum efficiency, FLO-DRI unit should be installed as indicated in Figure 1.
- 3.2 Install in a vertical position only.
- 3.3 Tighten fittings into casting 5.5 to 6.0 turns. Do not over-tighten threaded connections. This may lead to thread damage or possible cracking of the casting.
- 3.4 Ensure flow direction is as indicated on the unit.
- 3.5 Installation of drain leg is highly recommended.



1.0 FILTER MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.1 The following simple maintenance procedures will ensure maximum FLO-DRI filtering efficiency and a longer filter life.
- 1.2 FLO-DRI cartridges should be examined frequently until a pattern of usage is established.
- 1.3 Failure to replace cartridges in an expedient fashion may result in excessive pressure drop and the possibility of contaminant carry over. Refer to the Flo-Dri Cartridge Change-Out Calculator available on CCI Thermal's website for recommended change out schedules. This calculator allows the user to determine an accurate cartridge replacement schedule based on their specific application. If the calculator is unavailable, replace cartridges every 30 days or when the cartridge appears to be contaminated.
- 1.4 Do not subject the unit to vapours or liquids from synthetic solvents, acetone, methanol, esters, lacquer thinners, phosphates, etc.



The table above shows cartridge change-out frequencies in days for each model heater and gas scrubber for H_2S and moisture.

To determine the cartridge change-out frequency in days for other H_2S or moisture concentrations, use the formulas provided in the following examples:

Example 1: Sour Gas H,S

Change-out =
$$\#DAYS$$
 $\times \left[\frac{10 \text{ ppm}}{H_2 \text{S in Gas Supply}} \right]$

Your installation has a Cata-Dyne [™] heater, model WX 12 x 24, 10,000 Btu/hr (2.928 kW/hr) natural gas using a model FLODRI-10MS cartridge

- The concentration of H₂S in your gas supply is 25 ppm.
- The change-out frequency for 10 ppm is 70 days (derived from Table 4).
- COF = 56 days x 10ppm / 25 ppm = 22 days.
- The FLODRI-10MS scrubber cartridge should be changed once every 22 days.




Your installation has a Cata-Dyne[™] heater, model WX 12 x 24, 10,000 Btu/hr (2.928 kW/hr) natural gas using a model FLODRI-10MS cartridge.

- The concentration of moisture in your gas supply is 25 ppm.
- The change-out frequency for 50 ppm is 45 days (derived from Table 4).
- COF = 45 days x 50 ppm / 25 ppm = 90 days.
- The FLODRI-10MS scrubber cartridge should be changed once every 90 days.


